The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) is holding an open house to discuss the planned bridge rehabilitation on M-63 over I-94 in St. Joseph Township, Berrien County.

The informational meeting will be held 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 8, 2012, at the Saint Joseph Township Hall, 3000 Washington Avenue, Saint Joseph, MI.

The \$810,000 project is scheduled for May 29, 2012, to mid July 2012, and will involve a full closure of M-63 over the I-94 bridge. Various detours and intermittent ramp closures will be necessary.

MDOT staff will be on-hand at the open house to discuss the project and potential impacts of M-63 closures and detours. Interested residents and business owners are encouraged to attend.

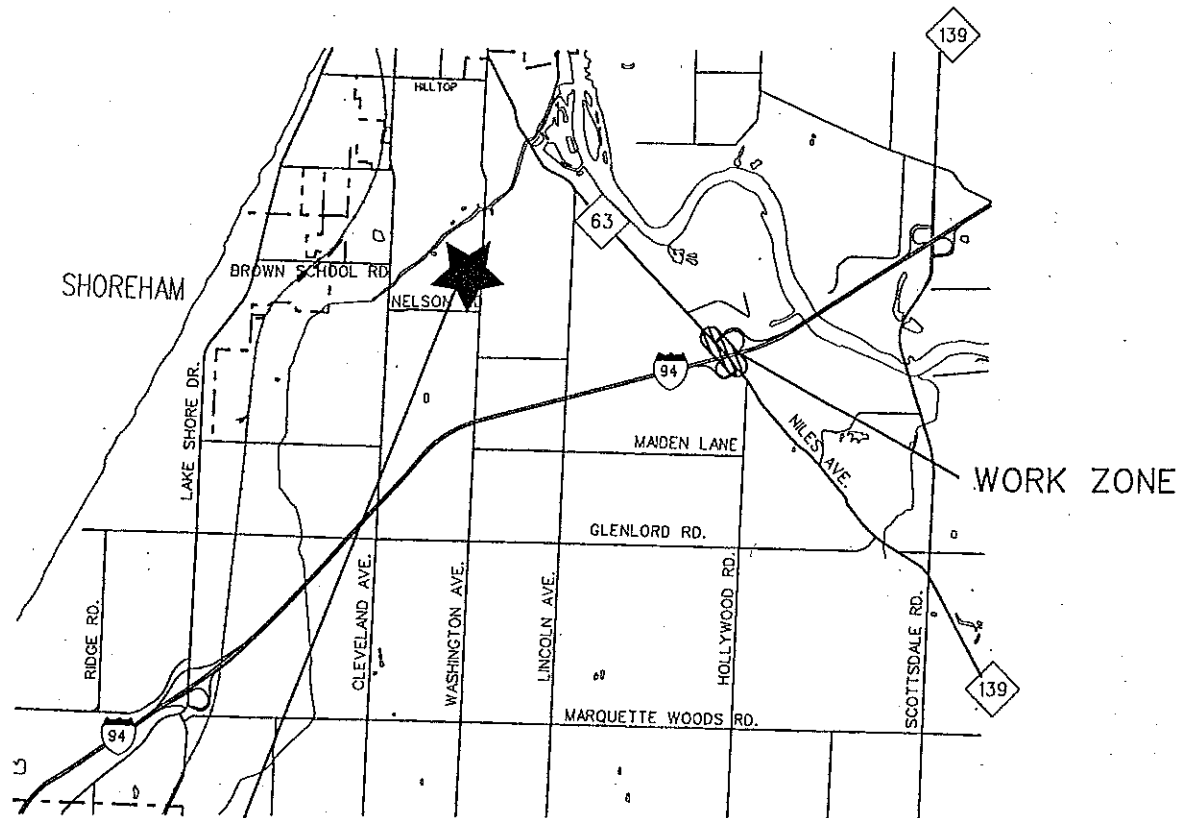

I-94 freeway on-ramps will be closed to traffic for a duration of one week.

M-63 bridge over I-94 will be closed to traffic for the duration of the project.

THE PROJECT

M-63 over I-94.

Shallow concrete overlay, joint replacement, railing replacement, partial and full depth deck repair, concrete beam repairs, substructure repairs, painting sealing assemblies, approach work and maintaining traffic.

Estimated cost for the project is \$810,000.
