Training Overview

Every year local agencies must collect PASER rating data on at least 50% of their paved federal-aid eligible roads and then submit the data to the Transportation Asset Management Council (TAMC).

The Center for Technology & Training (CTT) will be conducting a series of rater training sessions on behalf of the TAMC. All raters who plan to evaluate federal-aid eligible roads in 2012 must attend one of these training sessions.

Cost and Registration

All participants must register in advance for the training sessions. Space is limited.

The cost to attend this training will be as follows:

- Public Agencies:** \$10.00
- Non Act-51 Agency or Private Company:** \$20.00
