<b>Battle Creek Linear Trail</b> Battle Creek (269) 966-3431	Over <b>22 miles</b> of trails wind through wooded areas, open fields, parks, and some commercial areas. Historical, cultural, and point of interest signs are also found along the trail. <a href="http://www.bcparks.org/jsps/linear_park.jsp">www.bcparks.org/jsps/linear_park.jsp</a>	<b>Al Sabo Land Preserve</b> Kalamazoo (269) 375-1591	<b>7 miles</b> of mountain bike trails go through this land preserve. <b>Holland Zeeland Bike Path Network</b> Holland (800) 506-1299	Several miles of a local bike path network including multi-use paths separated from the main roads and on-road connections. Lawless Park</b> Cassopolis (269) 445-8611	<b>10 miles</b> of tight mountain biking trails for all difficulties. M-60 to Lewis Lake Rd. S. on Lewis Lake 1 mi. to Monkey Run Rd. <b>Kalamazoo River Valley Trail (KRVT)</b> Kalamazoo (269) 373-5073	The KRVT connects the Kal-Haven Trail, the Battle Creek Linear Park, and the Portage Bicentennial Trail. <b>Kal-Haven Trail</b> South Haven (269) 674-8011	A <b>34 mile</b> crushed limestone/slag trail connecting South Haven and Kalamazoo. The trail meanders through wooded areas, past farmlands, over rivers, and streams. <b>Paul Henry Thornapple Trail</b> Middleville (269) 795-3385	The trail passes through farmlands, woodlands, small towns, and along rivers and creeks. The scenic highlight of the trail is its close proximity to the Thornapple River. Sections of the trail are closed Nov-Dec. <a href="http://www.thornappletrail.com">http://www.thornappletrail.com</a>	<b>Madeline Bertrand Park (MB)</b> (269) 683-8280	<b>MB: 2.2 miles</b> of trail with a hard packed natural surface along the St. Joseph River.
		<b>Love Creek Park (LC)</b> (269) 471-2617	<b>LC: 4.25 miles</b> of beginning to intermediate level mountain bike trails.  <a href="http://www.berriencounty.org/parks">www.berriencounty.org/parks</a>
<b>Portage Bicentennial Linear Park</b> Portage (269) 329-4522	A network of biking trails with parking at Milham Road (just east of Westnedge), Garden Lane (at Celery Flats), or the Portage District Library. <a href="http://www.portagemi.gov">http://www.portagemi.gov</a>	<b>Markin Glen Park</b> Kalamazoo (269) 381-7570	Only the downhill course is open to biking. <b>Van Buren Trail</b> South Haven (269) 674-8011	A <b>14 mile</b> dirt/gravel multi-use trail that runs between Hartford and South Haven.
