## 2045 Long Range Plan

Brandon Kovnat introduced and presented the Non-Motorized Technical memo. See attached. Jan Personette commented that law enforcement has been pulling people over looking for distracted drivers. Don Ryman stated that people should be able to ride bikes on sidewalks. Eric Lester asked if there was a connections with other factors in peoples commute patterns. Kim Gallagher responded that staff will be presenting the demographic and socioeconomic

factors for the NATS area at the November NATS meeting. Lester asked if Uber or a cab might be a better fit than transit to provide rides to work, medical ect.

Sandra Seanor explained that MACOG had utilized a service for years in Elkhart years ago where taxis provided demand response service to people who were registered with the transit system. Georgia Boggs expressed her concern for people riding their bikes and walking along 11<sup>th</sup> street at night for work. Michael Majerick commented that M-51 goes through Main Street in downtown Niles and creates vibrations and accidents. Joe Ray responded that the intersection of Main, 10<sup>th</sup> and Broadway probably have the highest incidence of crashes.

Council Member Bertschy offered the following resolution and moved for its adoption, seconded by Council Member Weimer.

BY THE CITY OF NILES, MICHIGAN - NILES CITY COUNCIL:

WHEREAS, 17th Street is in deteriorating condition; and

WHEREAS, a detailed structural evaluation has been performed for the 2018 is 17th Street from Broadway to E, Main Street, 0.57 miles and the inspection has identified preventing maintenance measures that if implemented in a timely manner will avoid more extensive and costlier repairs in the future; and

WHEREAS, the 17th Street Project provides a connection to other major streets; and

WHEREAS, the City of Niles is committing their share of the funding for the 2018 fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the engineering estimate for the design and reconstruction of the 17th Street project is as follows:

TOTAL CONSTRUCTION COST	FEDERAL FUNDING	CITY SHARE
\$195,000	\$159,000	\$36,000

WHEREAS, the Niles-Buchanan-Cass Area Transportation Study Policy Committee has agreed to allocate a portion of local Surface Transportation Program funds (STP) through the project selection process; and

WHEREAS, the Niles-Buchanan-Cass Area Transportation Study Policy Committee requires all projects in the Niles-Buchanan-Cass Area Transportation Study 2017-2020 Transportation Improvement Program that uses local match to have a formal resolution of support from the jurisdiction paying for the local share of the project; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Niles City Council hereby certifies its support of the local share of the project's cost that will be included in the 2017-2020 Niles-Buchanan-Cass Area Transportation Study Transportation Improvement Program and that failure to provide for the local match will cause the project's allocation of Niles-Buchanan-Cass Area Transportation Study local Surface Transportation Funding to be reconsidered by the Niles-Buchanan-Cass Area Transportation Study Policy Committee.
