Why plan for Non-Motorized Transportation?

- Street Intersection Signage/ Markings
- Boat Access (Kayaks, Canoes, etc.)
- Signage





<u>Site Amenities</u> Parking, Signage, Restrooms, Seating, Trash Receptacles, Boat Racks/ Slides

Launch Designs, Location, Condition

Aware of disturbances to natural wildlife, vegetation. Aware of depth of water, turbulence, conflict w/ other boaters Provide firm walking condition (dock or ground) Gentle downhill slope of 8% or less Create nearby staging area between parking and launch
