1. CALL TO ORDER

Dick Stauffer called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. and led the group in introductions.

2. CHANGES TO THE AGENDA

None.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT

None.

4. MINUTES

Motion to approve the January 23, 2017 Joint Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) & Policy Committee Meeting Minutes, by Steve Tilley, Second by Dick Stauffer. **Motion approved.**

5. STAFF REPORT

Kim Gallagher explained that the presentation on safety data and technical brief would be postponed. Kim went over the performance measures and explained that two measures require VMT history to complete. The safety technical brief is expected to be sent out in a week and will be discussed at the March meeting.

6. COMMUNITY LAND USE AND ZONING UPDATES

None.

7. PUBLIC TRANSIT

SWMPC

Kim Gallagher provided an update to the Berrien Countywide Public Transit Service Planning efforts. She reminded the group that the plan to combine the four transit agencies in Berrien County was separate from the service plan SWMPC was coordinating with Nelson Nyygaard. A Steering Committee was created with one member from each system and from the no service area, including: City of Niles, City of Benton Harbor, City of Buchanan, Berrien County, no service area, employment, and finance. Three stakeholder meeting will be held in mid-April followed by public meetings in May. Kim showed the committee the plan's website and explained that the plan now has the name ConnectBerrien

TCATA

Bill Purvis explained that the grant proposal for JARC was due and that the budget wasn't known until right beforehand. This then affected the general operating expenses as well. An amendment was made to TCATA's 5307 funding and the JARC funding. It was made administratively and has already been submitted to MDOT.

8. AIRPORT

None.

9. AGENCY PROJECT STATUS

Berrien County Road Commission project status reviewed:

- Hilltop Road Grade Inspection: 10/25/2016, Final Plan Estimate to MDOT: 12/2/2016, Project was let: 2/3/2017
- River Road Obligated: 10/19/2016, Project was let: 2/3/2017
- John Beers Road: the project was extended 0.32 miles East to pave in front of Hollywood Elementary; Grade Inspection Package & Meeting: 1/4/2017. Expected letting in April.

There will be a one-week closure on Hilltop to work on a railroad crossing.

Chris Cook stated that Stevensville's Red Arrow-John Beers intersection project has been obligated.

MDOT project status reviewed:

- I-96 overlay in ROW phase with consultant chosen.
- M-139 Passing Flare in ROW and PE phase with a consultant to be used as needed.
- M-63 Overlay awaiting final plan submittal for an estimated letting on 4/7/2017.
- M-63 Crack Fill turned in for February letting.
- US-31 Longitudinal Joint Repair let and came in approximately 6% under scheduled for construction to start in mid-August.
- I-94 Road and Bridge Scoping in EPE phase with an RFP being put together.

There will be a 1-way detour on M-63 during construction. Also there will be meetings in the fall to discuss the I-94 bridge scoping and solicit input from local communities.

10. OLD BUSINESS

None.

11. NEW BUSINESS

Chris cook presented an amendment for the city of Benton Harbor to move the Colfax Avenue Resurfacing from 2019 to 2017. This will be done using advance construct. Chris explained that Colfax avenue was in such bad state that they couldn't wait till 2019 for repairs. They will from the cost in 2017 and get reimburse in 2019. The project cost remains the same.

Bill Purvis presented amendments for TCATA. In 2017 TCATA is adding:

A bus to the JARC Line. \$68,398 federal 5307 and \$17,100 state for a \$85,498 total cost

A phone system to manage office and dispatch calls \$7,200 Federal 5307 and \$1,800 State for a \$9,000 Total Cost

Bill Purvis also is adding in additional 5307 funds to 2017 which had been granted in 2016. He explained that there was a switch in the software from TEAM to TRANS. He said that

when the switch occurred he couldn't access any of his funds. The FTA had finally fixed the issue and released the funds. These funds will be used for:

2017 Operating Expenses: \$118,701 Radios: \$2,776 Total \$121,477

Jonathan Smith presented an amendment for MDOT to add to 2017: I-94 Substructure repair over I-94 BL (Lakeshore Dr.)

Jonathan explained that their repairs could not wait till the scoping project was completed.

Brian Berndt added in two additional amendments which he had not submitted before the meeting. The Berrien County Road Commission is received a Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) grant for \$600,000. Since some of this will be used within the TwinCATS area, Brian was informed that the funds needed to entered into the TIP.

The additional work on Hilltop at the rail crossing will be using a separate funding source and therefore this new project needs to be added to the TIP. the funds are split 60/40 between the state and the rail company, CSX.

Motion for the Technical Advisory Committee to recommend that the Policy Committee approve all of the presented amendments to the TIP made by Juan Ganum, Second by Terrie Smith. **Motion Approved**

Motion for the Policy Committee to approve all of presented amendments to the transportation impartment program made by Dick Stauffer, second by Tim Lynch. **Motion Approved**

State and Federal Updates

Jim Sturdevant said that MDOT and SWMPC would be meeting next week to discuss the Unified Work Plan.

12. PRIVILEGE OF THE FLOOR

There was a question about the Napier Avenue Corridor Grant. Kim said that SWMPC director Jon Egelhaaf would be coordinating this project. She also explained that she was

working on the countywide transit study and since she just got through the first steering committee meeting SWMPC would have more time to devote to Napier Avenue.

There was a request for MDOT to fix the Cleveland avenue overpass over I-94. This road is such poor shape it is dangerous to drive on parts of it. Jonathan Smith was able to send the request directly through and received confirmation that work on this section would begin in the Spring.
