

SOUTHWEST MICHIGAN REGION ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE*

*Environmental Justice (EJ) areas are selected by two criterias:


- 1) The minority population that is above Michigan's average of 21.1%.
- 2) The number of households that are considered living below the poverty level and is greater than the Michigan's average of 16.7%.

The EJ areas have either or both of these criterias.

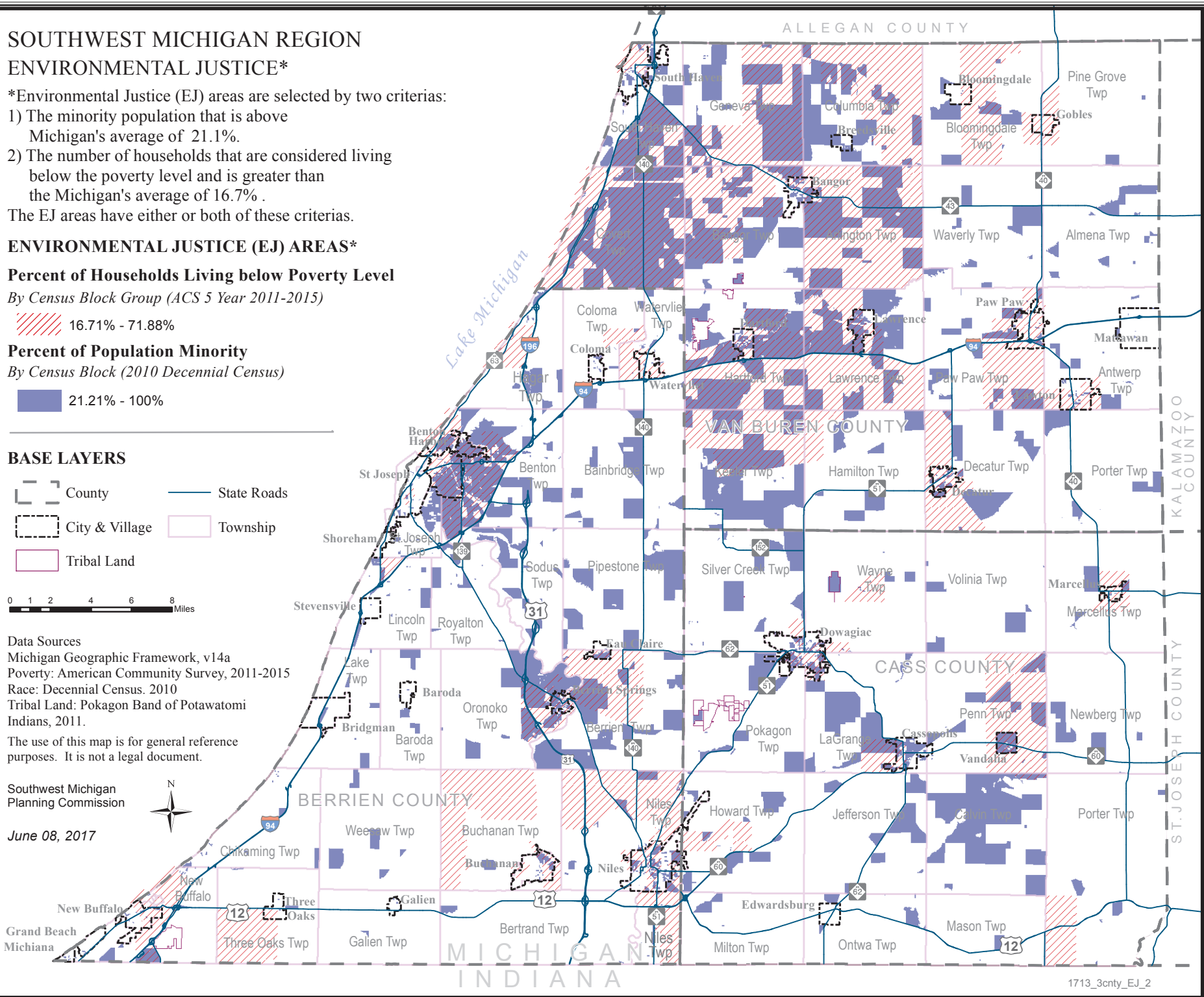
