1. CALL TO ORDER

5. FEATURED PLANNER PRESENTATION – EDA

Director Egelhaaf introduced Associate Planner, Jerrid Burdue, who gave on overview of the projects that he has been working on since joining SWMPC in May. Among the topics he discussed were the CEDS Annual Report, SWMPC Annual Report and an update of Palisades Nuclear Plant closure. Rich Remus inquired if we have been in contact with Cook Nuclear Plant, Egelhaaf stated that we have not yet been funded, therefore are not fully engaged.
