

Mission Statement



 The mission of SMART is to partner, promote and connect a planned trailway system in Southwest Michigan and adjoining areas to enhance the quality of life for all.

Trailway Definition

- A recreational facility that would include but is not limited to:
 - Hiking trails
 - Water trails
 - Non-motorized trails
 - Equestrian trails
 - Snowmobile trails
 - Bicycle trails

 Establish and expand partnerships that aid the development and connection of trailways throughout Southwest Michigan.



- Build strong public participation and awareness of the alliance's purpose and activities.
- Maintain and update a list of partnering organizations.
- Build capacity of existing organizations to develop trailways.

 Link existing and future trailways into a complete network connecting the Southwest Michigan region with neighboring networks.



- Develop a planned regional trailway system that connects people with other people, nature, water, history, culture and art.
- Encourage trailways to be safe for all users.

Secure resources to sustain success.

- Create a vision document to communicate with potential funding sources.
- Identify key funding sources and ideas.
- Establish long term funding strategies for maintenance of trailway network.


- Evaluate the need for a coordinator/staff person for the alliance.
- Establish a 501 (c 3) or (c 6) to channel grants through.
- Establish a volunteer program.

- Assist communities and organizations with marketing and promoting ideas and techniques.
