The BATF will have an opportunity to make adjustments to these recommendations and to develop a list of priority action items that will become the focus of SWMPC's overall Southwest Michigan Broadband Initiative (SWMBI). Subsequently, the SWMBI will be promoted and supported by SWMPC staff throughout local units of government and among institutions within the region.
