**Summary of Proposed Changes**

- The FY 2023 Berrien CMAQ allocation of \$804,254 can be used anywhere within the county (on a project that reduces transportation emissions).
- The Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) and the Carbon Reduction Program (CRP) must be spent within the MPO boundaries which they allocated for.
- On October 28, 2022 MDOT announced substantial increases to the FY 2023 STBG allocations for TwinCATS and NATS.

- The proposal is to swap CMAQ funds for CRP and STBG funds, for all of the CMAQ projects currently programed in 2023, to free up CMAQ funding for a project elsewhere in the county. Additional STBG funding is included in the proposal to minimize the local or state match for each project based on the latest cost estimates.
  - \$386,517 in CMAQ funds will be replaced with \$396,413 of TwinCATS STBG and \$135,856 in TwinCATS CRP.
  - \$287,314 in CMAQ funds will be replaced with \$246,703 in NATS STBG and \$78,873 in NATS CRP

- Berrien Bus informed SWMPC that they do need the van in 2023 which is currently programed with \$56,000 in FY 2023 CMAQ funds.
- From the newly freed up CMAQ funds, \$608,682 are proposed for use on the Red Arrow Highway Non-motorized Path, which is a project on the approved CMAQ illustrative list. This project is already in design as a component of the road work on Red Arrow Highway.
- The proposed changes would leave a FY 2023 CMAQ balance of \$179,612.

2. The TwinCATS and NATS Policy Committees vote to approve the proposal.
3. SWMPC will submit changes to MDOT, for state and federal approval.
4. TCATA will request flexing STBG to FTA 5307.
