


# Saugatuck-South Haven Blue Star Trail



## Saugatuck-South Haven Blue Star Trail Anticipated Benefits

### Local Economy and Businesses

Michigan studies show that trail users from out of town spend anywhere from **\$949 to \$1,269** on lodging, restaurant, groceries, vehicle expenses, equipment, etc. per trip. The average annual use of six Michigan trails was **92,000 uses**. This equates to a significant amount of spending from trail users.

### Property Values = Property Taxes

Realtors have indicated that homes on the Paint Creek Trail (Michigan) typically sell for about **10% more** than comparable homes “off the trail”.

“Properties along the trail have taken off... I’ve gotten a list of 300 prospective buyers waiting for property along the river and trail, and they are willing to wait just for those properties”. **Suzan Beal, sales associate with Coldwell Banker Real Estate**
