




POTECTING RIPAR

An ordinance enacted under the Michigan Wetland Protection provisions of Act 451 of 1994, to provide for the preservation, management, protection and use of wetlands in the township of Fabius, to require permits to alter certain wetlands; to provide for a plan for the preservation, management, protection and use of wetlands; and to provide remedies and penalties for violation thereof.

The Township of Fabius, County of St. Joseph Michigan Ordains;

ARTICLE 1 - SHORT TITLE

Section 100 - Short Title.

This ordinance shall be known and may be cited as the "Fabius Township Wetlands Protection Ordinance".

ARTICLE 2 – PURPOSE

Section 200 - Purpose

The purpose of this Ordinance is:

To provide for the protection and appropriate use of wetlands within Fabius Township in order to minimize disturbance of these vital natural features;

To coordinate the provisions of this Ordinance with state law as well as to provide for coordinated enforcement of wetland protection laws and requirements by responsible township, county and state officials.

To assign responsibilities for assuring the protection of wetlands within Fabius Township. To establish procedures for the processing of applications for permits involved in the permitted use of wetlands in Fabius Township.














Fabius Township Zoning Map





Dear Property Owner:

This letter is sent to you because you are listed as an owner of property that possibly contains or is adjacent to a protected wetland. It is important that you educate yourself about the importance of wetlands, the need to protect them, permit requirements at the state and township levels, and penalties for performing work without a permit. Properly protecting wetlands on your property may increase your property value and enhance local water quality.

Please take a moment to read the enclosed brochure provided by the Michigan Department of Environmental Quality entitled, "A Property Owner's Guide to Wetland Protection in Michigan".

Wetlands are a desirable, irreplaceable natural resource, and it has been estimated that nearly 35% of Fabius Township's land area contains wetlands. Wetlands are part of the balance of a healthy environment; they are complex systems that serve vital ecological functions and provide many benefits to the communities in which they are found. Yet more than 40% of the wetlands that were present in Michigan at the time the territory was made a state have disappeared by filling, dredging or other destructive procedures. We are dedicated to enforcing the ordinance that has been carefully created here in Fabius Township!

Because wetlands are so critical there are Federal, State, County and Township laws protecting these abundant resources. Affected property owners are subject to regulations under the State of Michigan Statutes and the Fabius Township Wetlands Protection Ordinance. State and federal laws also regulate many activities under the Inland Lakes and Streams Act. In addition, Soil Erosion permits may be required from the St. Joseph County Soil Conservation District for work performed on your property.

The State of Michigan and Fabius Township Wetland Protection laws are not the same; hence, permits may be required from one or the other, and are often required from both the State of Michigan and Fabius Township if wetlands are involved. Obtaining a permit from the State, County or Township does not excuse the lack of any other required permits. All persons are responsible for determining whether State, County or Township permits are required, and to obtain the necessary permits BEFORE commencing on any regulated activity.

The Township Wetlands Protection Ordinance controls most activities that might occur in or near wetlands, lakes, streams or ponds. Buffer zones of 25 feet around the outside edge of wetlands are required; they also serve as barriers to geese and reduce the cost and effort required for yard

All I want to do is

While usually contractors get all the needed permits, it is good for us to know the different agencies and what they cover. Some people use contractors who are from out of the area and even out of the state. So here is a summary. In ALL cases it is better to check the CORRECT official than guess. Penalty fines can get big! Contact information is at the bottom of the article.

IF YOU PLAN ON CONSTRUCTING A BUILDING

You need to start with the Fabius TWP Zoning Administrator, Doug Kuhlman. When you have a Zoning Permit, he will refer you to the Building Administrator. Mike Alwine.

If you are within 500 ft of the lake, you will need a Soil Erosion Permit. The permitting process is handled by the Drain Commissioner, Jeff Wenzel.

You may also need a Township Wetlands permit. The Zoning Administrator will refer you to the Chair of the Wetlands Committee, Vic Eichler.

If the building will need water and a septic tank, you will have to contact the Health Department.

IF YOU PLAN ON DOING LANDSCAPING

If you will be moving dirt within 500' of a lake or stream, you will need a Soil Erosion Permit from the Drain Commissioner. Depending on how close to the water you will be, you may need permits from the TWP Wetlands and from the Michigan Dept. of Environmental Quality (DEQ). Any retaining wall over 4' needs a building permit.

IF YOU PLAN ON BUILDING A SEAWALL OR PUTTING SAND ON YOUR BEACH

You must get a permit from the DEQ and probably from the Drain Commissioner.

You may also need a permit from the TWP Wetlands. State Law requires that large stones or other materials called 'riprap' must be placed on the lake side of the seawall to break up the scouring action of waves at the foot of your seawall.




Fabius Township has been informed that there was a request made to State of Michigan, Department of Environmental Quality, for a beach sanding permit on the property you own at Clear Lake in Fabius Township. The permit was requested by Gerald Ludwick, on behalf of Coon Hollow Properties, LLC, but the tax records show the property is owned by you and your husband (whom, I am told, is now deceased; please accept my condolences), and not Coon Hollow Properties, LLC, there is also nothing of record to show that Mr. Ludwick has your written authority to act on your behalf in obtaining or acting on any such permit.

A permit is required to be applied for, and obtained, from Fabius Township, before any activities such as dredging and filling may be done in this area, which is a wetlands. No such permit has been applied for, or given. A permit from DEQ does not satisfy the requirement of a permit from the Township.


There is concern on the part of the Township, because there has been recent activity (dumping/filling of soil or sand) in the wetlands on the above-referenced parcel, which activity in the past had been found to violate the State of Michigan wetlands and other laws, and the St. Joseph County Soil Conservation District soil erosion permit terms. Last summer, I was present when the DEQ posted violation notices on the

















