## What does the future hold for public transit in Berrien County?

Today Berrien County currently has four agencies providing bus service to residents:

- Twin Cities Area Transportation Authority (Twin City Dial-A-Ride)
- Niles Dial-A-Ride Transit
- Buchanan Dial-A-Ride Transit
- Berrien County Transit (Berrien Bus)

With changing trends such as the aging population, growing number of individuals with disabilities, and rising gas prices, the county is seeing a **rising need for public transit service, paired with declining funds for operating transit**. A significant portion of the county, which is the fastest growing, has no public transit service available at all.

The Southwest Michigan Planning Commission has conducted two studies of the public transit needs in the county, and has now hired consultants KFH Group, Inc. to conduct a feasibility study for coordination and consolidation of public transit in Berrien County, which will look at different types and levels of coordination of service. The goal of the study is to identify ways to develop a **seamless transportation system that provides convenient, high-quality service for riders and contributes to quality of life in Berrien County**.
