7. Airport Updates

Des Jardins said that the airport was conducting stormwater inspections paid for out of pocket. They are also building additional hangers.

8. Public Transit Updates

Little said TCATA was going through a tough period with no federal 5307 funding due to the federal government shutdown. Awarding bids for bus cameras, and will soon be able to put their new busses into service. Due to the shutdown being over January 25, members asked if the federal government processing still had not caught up. Little said they had not.

9. Special Studies

- A) Countywide Transit Study: No update.
- **B)** Napier Corridor Study: Stack said that they are doing simulation & modeling for the reduction from 4 to 3 lanes.

10. Project Updates & Amendments

Berrien County Road Department Project updates

- Roosevelt Path: Obligation expected in August 2019 and construction will occur in late fall until summer 2020.
- Napier Avenue: Obligation expected in April 2019.
- John Beers Rd: Final plans submitted to MDOT in February. Obligation expected in April 2019.

Amendment to add a project for the Berrien County Road Department

Stack said that the additional project was a replacement for another RTF project, which was going to be on Red Arrow Highway. The new project on Napier will be within Benton Township and Bainbridge Township, but is being split into two job numbers so that funding is not split between the MPO and non-MPO areas.
