## Minutes TWIN CITIES AREA TRANSPORTATION STUDY JOINT TECHNICAL ADVISORY COMMITTEE AND POLICY COMMITTEE MEETING October 16, 2023

#### 1. Call to Order and Roll Call

Policy Committee Chair, Dick Stauffer, called the meeting to order at 9:30 am and Kim Gallagher conducted roll call.

- 2. <u>Changes to the Agenda</u> None.
- 3. <u>Public Comment</u> None.
- Approval of September 17, 2023 Meeting Minutes
   Motion to approve the minutes from the September 17, 2023 TwinCATS combined Policy and Technical
   Advisory Committee meeting. Made by Jim Sturdevant and seconded by John Hodgson. Motion approved.
- 5. <u>SWMPC Staff Report</u>

Gallagher gave an update on the Adjusted Census Urban Boundaries (ACUB). Originally, staff planned to present the revised ACUB for approval at the October meeting, but due to delays at MDOT, this has been postponed until November. The proposed 2020 ACUB can be found online by searching "MDOT 2020 ACUB." Staff will send the official PDF map before the November meeting. The ACUB is used to classify roads as urban/rural for road funding purposes. Transit uses the Census defined urban boundary.

6. Local Road Agency Updates

Gallaher reminded the committee that the funding estimates for 2024-2026 had been updated based on the 2020 census.

#### 7. Local Road Agency Amendments

**Subcommittee Recommendations for 2024-2026 STBG Funds:** A Subcommittee comprised of Tim Drews, Tim Zebell, and Kevin Stack, met on October 9th to develop a recommendation for how to utilize TwinCATS unprogrammed 2024-2026 (*See Meeting packet page 7 for details*).

Additional details about adding Cleveland Avenue for St. Joseph in 2026 were discussed. This is a top project on the TwinCATS illustrative list. mentioned that the federal funding amount of \$228,000 was based on his estimate from a couple of years ago, and the current estimate has not been calculated yet. To legally approve a project, the total estimated cost must be presented. TwinCATS will have all the details to approve this project when they approve the entire 2026-2029 Transportation Improvement Program.

Cleveland Aveue south of hilltop was also a top illustrative project. Stack had told the subcommittee he didn't want to wait tile 2026 for repairs and would fund a project locally.

**Marquette Greenway Phase 2:** Gallagher explained that this was being funded in 2025 by a RAISE grant awarded to the Northern Indiana Regional Planning Commission (NIRPC), who partnered with SWMPC for the Michigan portions of the Trail (*See Meeting packet page 5 for details*).

**Motion** for the technical Advisory Committee to recommend that the Policy Committee approve the Local Road project amendments to the TwinCATS 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program. Made by Roger Seeley and seconded by Cindy Gray. **Motion approved.** 

**Motion** for the Policy committee to approve the recommendation from the technical Advisory Committee. Made by Jim Sturdevant and seconded by John Hodgson. **Motion approved.** 

#### 8. Transit Updates

Gallagher introduced Rufas Addams, the new TCATA director.

#### 9. <u>Transit Amendments</u>

Oliver Lindsey presented the amendment request for TCATA (*See Meeting packet page 9 for details*). He said TCATA needed to request additional funding mainly due to the increase in the price of products and services.

Transit funding can be spent within a 4-6 year period after appropriation, unlike road funding, which must be spent in the year it was allocated. The state's match for Transit projects is derived from the current year's state budget, and the TIP reflects the year when state funding is approved. This is the reason that TCATA projects will be shifted from 2023 to 2024 in the TIP but will still be covered by TCATA's 2019 or 2023 FTA grant.

**Motion** for the Technical Advisory Committee to recommend that the Policy Committee approve the transit project amendments to the TwinCATS 2023-2026 Transportation Improvement Program. Made by Tim Zebell and seconded by Tim Drews. **Motion approved.**

#### 10. MDOT Project Updates

Smith gave an update on the following Projects:

#### M-139 form I-94 to Main Street/I-94 BL

- Final report completed, encompassing early preliminary engineering phase and stakeholder outreach.
- Scheduled meetings with engineers to discuss municipal utility replacements.

#### M-63/Main Street in St. Jospeh

- Contract in place.
- Discussions with the city of St. Joseph are occurring in November.
- Public engagement will occur in January 2024.

#### Lakeshore Drive and Niles Projects:

- These are 100% state-funded resurfacing and drainage adjustments.
- Collaboration with the city of St. Joseph for water service replacements.
- Agreement with the city to resurface two park and ride areas.

#### I-94 Paving Between 23 and 27 Eastbound:

• Temporary paving used for maintaining traffic during the reconstruction of I-94 on 2024.

# **MDOT PROEJCT STATUS**

## FY 2023 FUNDED PROJECTS

**Reconstruction of I-94 from exit 23 to Brittan Ave:** The project was let in June 2023 and came in 10.18% over the engineers estimate. Prep work is in progress until mid-November to install temp crossovers and culverts, temporary paving, and deliver traffic control items. The mainline I-94 work will start in spring of 2024. The Washington Avenue over I-94 bridge is being worked on in August 2023 and will be closed for approx. 3 weeks. **PREP WORK COMPLETED** 

Replacement of 17 dynamic messaging signs and adding CCTV cameras I-94 and I-196: PROJECT COMPLETE

Culvert Replacement on M-139 over Big Meadow Drian (north of Tanglewood Trl.: The Project was let in January 2023. Construction will begin in January 2024 with tree removals. Culvert work requiring the detour begins in May 2024 through August 2024.

**Reconstruction of M-139 from approx.** .44 miles south of I-94 to Main Street/I-94 BL: Currently finalizing the engineering report for the EPE phase. The PE phase will begin in September/October. MDOT has resolutions of support from Benton Township and City of Benton Harbor for the MDOT preferred alternative and will be moving forward with that in design. Plan completion is expected in May 2025 for an October 2025 letting. Construction is scheduled for 2026.

**Bridge repairs for overpasses on I-94 at M-139, Nickerson, & Rosyln and US-31 at Napier**: Design (PE) is in progress. Plan completion is expected in August 2024 for a January 2025 letting. Construction is scheduled for 2025.

## FY 2024 FUNDED PROJECTS

Wrong Way Movement Prevention on I-94 at exits 16,23 27,& 28: Design (PE) in progress. Plan completion expected in August 2023 for a December 2023 letting. Construction is scheduled for 2024.


**Bridge Rehabilitation for the Red Arrow Bridge over I-196**: Design (PE) will begin soon in FY 2024. Plan completion May 2026 for October 2026 letting. Construction is currently scheduled for 2027


**Reconstruction of M-63/Main St. from Central Ave. to the Blossomland and Bicentennial Bridges**: Early Design (EPE) phase is currently underway with field work and stakeholder engagement happing this fall/winter. PE phase will start next year. Plan completion is April 2026 for September 2026 letting. Construction is currently scheduled for 2027.

Maintenance on I-196 from Coloma Rd. to Central Ave.: Design (PE) is in progress. Plan completion is September 2023 for a December 2023 letting. Construction is currently scheduled for 2024.
