## Berrien County Ten-year Trends in Pavement Condition



Over 10 years pavement in poor condition experienced an increase from $27 \%$ ( 203 miles) to $52 \%$ ( 392 Miles). Over this same periiod roads in fair condition fell from 56\% (422 miles) to $32 \%$ ( 241 mile)
