### 1. Call to Order & Introductions

- Bellina called the meeting to order at 1:33 p.m. and led the group in introductions. Boyd led the group in the pledge of allegiance.

### 2. Minutes

**3. Public Comment**

**4. Staff Report**

- **Performance Measures Workgroup**

A meeting has been set up to work on the chapter for performance measures. Flowers will email the meeting information on Wednesday. This meeting will focus on developing the performance measures chapter in the long range plan.

- **TIP STP Allocations**

Flowers noted that once the federally approved TIP is received from MDOT that the MPO will be over programmed in the Local STP allocation. Flowers will be contacting the agencies with projects in the 2013 TIP to see if any project bid savings had been saved or discuss with them on to be back in fiscal constraint.

- **Climate Change Workshop in TwinCATS**

Mani noted that the TwinCATS MPO was a recipient of a climate change grant through MSU Extension and GLISA. The first public conversation will take place at Michigan Works on Wednesday February 27, 2013. If people are interested in attending they are welcomed to attend.

**4. Project Updates**

- **FY 2013 and FY 2014 Funding and Projects**

Flowers reported the estimated STP funds for 2013 and 2014 for the NATS area. Flowers suggested the possibility of a subcommittee or smaller working group to decide how to prioritize projects for 2013 and 2014 based on these funding levels and the current ability of local agencies to provide local match. Flowers noted that this was just one way to deal with the issue, and was the approach that TwinCATS had attempted.

**6. Old Business**

There was no old business.

**7. New Business**

- **TIP Amendments**

No TIP amendments were reviewed this month.

- **Brad Sharlow-Base Year 2010 Model Deficiencies**

Sharlow presented information to the Committee members noting the base year deficiencies to monitor in the long range plan. The segments included

- Front Street in Buchanan from Main to Red Bud Trail
- Main Street in Niles from M-139 to M-51
- Main Street in Niles from M-51 to 13<sup>th</sup> Street
- Grant Street in Niles from Parkway Street to 3<sup>rd</sup> Street

While none of these segments are at or over capacity they are approaching capacity and will need to be monitored. He stated that the volumes are a 24 hour daily capacity and that it is possible that these segments could be over capacity at am and pm hours of the day.

- **Long Range Transportation Planning Sections**

Flowers noted that in an effort to bring sections of the Long Range Plan to the Committee members in manageable chunks that there are several sections to review this month. She noted that these are working drafts and that final approval will not come until after the 10 day public comment period once the Committee members put the document out for public comment. Flowers also noted some comments from Kim O’Haver and that those will be incorporated.

- Goals and Objectives
- Non-motorized

- Coordination with State Long Range Plan

General comments from the Committee members included a find and replace to make sure that there is only NATS information, be careful of the maps included to only use those that are truly necessary, add information from the MDOT Chicago to Detroit rail study, include more freight information into the airport section and work with Joe Ray and Lee Scherwitz, justify documents on both sides. Comments were also received from Andrea Dewey and those comments will also be included.

A motion by Harden with support by Cooper to conditionally approve the draft sections of the long range plan and to continue to make progress on the sections of the Long Range Plan and to present them to the Committees. **Motion passed.**

- **Item to Review**

- Future Planning Sections

Flowers noted that in an attempt to more carefully monitor areas that are changing in the MPO, a section will be added to the long range plan. Kodis stated that if Flowers needed more demographic information from the MACOG area that he would assist Flowers.

▪ **Legislative Updates-Federal and State**

Boyd stated that Secretary of Transportation Ray LaHood is stepping down from his position and that his replacement has not yet been identified. There is also concern over the sequestration and how that would impact US DOT representatives such as Andrea Dewey and that furlough days may be in the future unless this is addressed.

Boyd also stated that each MPO was sent a letter regarding the \$54 million dollars worth of obligation authority and that a work group was formed in January to discuss what this would mean for the MPOs. She also stated that she will be working with policy officials at MDOT regarding the proposed funding bills. The four categories of bills include: Registration fees, Wholesale Gas Tax, Sales Tax, and Local Taxing Authority. Boyd will report back on this as more information is learned.

**8. Public Comment**

No public comments were received.

**9. Privilege of the Floor**

-Flowers had several items to share with Committee members:

- SWMPC will host 3 public meetings to engage the public in the TIP and LRP processes. All meetings will be held at the Niles Public Library from 5-7pm on March 27, April 24, and May 29. Legal notices and flyers will be sent to Committee members in the next couple of days. This is separate from the official public comment period but we want to give people more of an opportunity to share in the development of the process.
- TIP Project selection subcommittee meeting will be on Thursday February 28, 2013 at 1:30p.m. at the Niles City Hall.

-Boyd stated that Lenze is doing well and that he has gone through his first round of therapy for liver cancer. Flowers stated that she will bring a card for all members to sign next month.

-Getman-Dissette stated that the Senior Center in Niles is a great place to hold meetings with seniors and that Kathy Enders would be the best contact, she will share that information with Flowers.

-Frost noted that Dale Lowe had a broken leg that resulted in surgery and will be out for a while. Flowers stated that she had spoken with him and sent a card to him.
