1. Call to Order & Introductions

Meeting was called to order by Bellina at 1:04 p.m. Bellina led the group in introductions.

2. Minutes

A motion by Auvil with support by Gruchot to approve the TAC Committee Meeting minutes from January 22, 2014. **Motion passed.**

3. Public Comment

No public comments were received.

4. Staff Report

- **MTPA Follow up** – Flowers stated that the Michigan Transportation Planning Association meets monthly and that local agencies that are designing roads need to make sure that they plan for incorporation of ADA guidelines. This will add cost to local projects but is required. Flowers will find all documents from MDOT LAP and put them on the website for everyone’s convenience.

- **Local legislative letter regarding R3 funds**
 Mani stated that the TwinCATS MPO committee members discussed crafting a letter to the legislative representatives from our region regarding the MPO process and how important it is that our list of prioritized projects are utilized for any further selection of projects within the NATS MPO planning area. Flowers will draft a letter and send it out in the Committee Talking Point email later in the week.

- **Marcy Colclough Planning for Water Considerations**
 Colclough a Senior Planner at the Southwest Michigan Planning Commission discussed the function and value of wetlands for the region. She discussed what a wetland was, different types of wetlands and how much wetlands we have lost in the NATS planning area. This was of particular interest to Committee members as the freeze and thaw cycle of spring will be here very soon, and with so much loss in the function of intact wetlands areas could see more flooding areas in the watersheds where significant wetlands have been lost. The connection of land use planning, zoning and wetlands are all interconnected. Colclough offered her assistance to any of the local communities if they need maps or best practices to incorporate into local community planning documents.

6. Old Business

- **TIP supplemental questions**

Flowers stated that after the Committee discussions and discussions with MPO staff, the CMAQ questions will be incorporated into the TIP application instead of a separate application.

- **Administrative Modifications vs. Amendments Policy**

Flowers stated that many changes had been made to the policy and that the only area that needed to be addressed was the funding category. The only additional change to the policy made was under the corrections category, it was asked that we include project descriptions in the explanation. In addition, MPO staff needs to make sure that all reference to TwinCATS is removed.

A motion by Auvil with support by Harden to recommend the NATS TIP Amendments and Administrative Modifications Policy be approved by the Policy Committee. Motion passed.

▪ **Walk and Roll**

○ **Survey**

Flowers noted that the NATS Walk and Roll survey is ready for folks to fill out. This is a way to understand where citizens in the NATS planning area would like to have non-motorized facilities.

○ **Community stakeholder meetings**

Flowers stated that this was the final time to ask communities to have an opportunity to meet with MPO staff and map where they would like to see non-motorized facilities. MPO staff will move forward with having community input meetings in the spring, map those and bring them back to the MPO.

▪ **Seasonal traffic count locations**

Mani asked people to start thinking about where they would like traffic counts located in their communities. He also asked that if people have roads where they see seasonal traffic variations to let MPO staff know, these are roadways that we want to start monitoring.

James Turnwald from MACOG added that they will be working on their seasonal traffic counts in late April and there will be a 1 mile buffer from the state line for their travel demand model.

7. New Business

▪ **TIP Amendments**

Two amendments are being proposed to be changed in the 2014-2017 TIP:

- City of Niles-Adding FY 2018 to illustrative list in the amount of 13, 520 for the 17th Street Project.
- Amending FY 2015 Buchanan Dial a Ride operating expenses from estimates to actual projected amounts.

A motion by Berndt with support by Harden to recommend to the Policy Committee to approve the TIP amendments as presented. Motion passed.

▪ **Legislative Updates-Federal and State**

○ **Federal**

At the TwinCATS meeting on Monday, Andrea Dewey from FHWA discussed the Performance Measures framework that will be coming out possibly at the end of March or the beginning of April.

○ **State**

The state Senate just passed a \$100 million dollar spending bill from the Roads Risk and Reserve Funds pot of funds to go to all Act 51 agencies to help cover the costs of winter maintenance. There is no information on what the House may do at this point.

Flowers asked Cass County where they were in their winter maintenance dollars and Bellina noted that they are more than \$500,000 over spent, Berndt noted a similar issue in Berrien County where they are already \$1 million over spent on this winter.

8. Public Comment

No public comments were received.

9. Privilege of the Floor

Flowers stated that the next joint MPO meeting will be held April 30, 2014 from 1-5 in Berrien Springs.

Getman-Dissette announced that she is leaving Niles Dial a Ride and that this was her last meeting. She will now be working for Ottawa County Economic Development.

Jolivette noted that Sarah Woolcock has officially retired from MDOT and circulated a card.

10. Adjournment at 2:01p.m.

A motion by Harden with support by Auvil to adjourn the meeting.
