## **Township Plan Adoption Process**

- 1. Planning Commission submits proposed plan to the Township Board for review and comment.
- 2. Township Board acts on the proposed plan. Township Board approves the distribution of the proposed plan to the following entities:

Planning Commission or legislative body of each contiguous municipality and county Regional planning commission (Southwest Michigan Planning Commission) County Planning Commission Public Library (optional)

- 3. Send a letter to the County Planning Commission stating that the step number 2 was completed and list the names and addresses of each planning commission or legislative body the proposed plan was sent to.
- 4. Township Board adopts a resolution which asserts the right of the Township Board to approve or reject the plan. (optional)
- 5. Review period for the above entities is 63 days. All comments should be submitted to the Township Planning Commission and the County Planning Commission.
- 6. Township Planning Commission prepares a response to the comments received at the end of the 63 days. Any revisions or changes to the plan are made as a result of the comments received. (optional)
- 7. Township Planning Commission, by resolution, adopts by majority vote to hold a public comment period and then a public hearing on the plan. (The hearing must occur within 83 days of steps 2 and 5).
- 8. Publish the hearing date twice in the newspaper of general circulation in the Township. The 1<sup>st</sup> publication should not be ore than 30 days or less than 20 days before the date of the hearing. The 2<sup>nd</sup> publication should not be more than 8 days before the date of the hearing. Notice should include the place and times people can borrow, read or copy the proposed plan; where to mail comments and where and when the hearing will be held.
- 9. The Township Planning Commission holds a formal hearing on the plan more than 83 days after step 2.
- 10. The Township Planning Commission prepares a response to the comments received at the public hearing. (optional) Any changes are made to the plan if needed.
- 11. The Township Planning Commission, by resolution, adopts by majority vote of the entire membership to approve the final plan. (Or if step 4 was taken, the Township Planning Commission adopts a resolution to submit the final version of the plan to the Township Board.)
- 12. If step 4 was takes, the Township Board approves the plan or rejects it with comments to the planning commission.
- 13. If adopted, a copy of the adopted plan is sent to the entities listed in Step 2.
