**3. Purpose of Meeting**

- To review 2010 and 2011 projects already in 2008-2011 TIP; to review projects previously selected for fiscal years 2012 and 2013 during 2010-2013 TIP selection process; to select projects for 2014 and fill in funding gaps in 2011-2013; to review transit projects and MDOT projects for 2010 through 2014; and to identify Surface Transportation and Jobs for Main Street illustrative lists of projects.

- It was noted that Broad Street has another row in the TIP document accounting for the \$42,226 of ARRA funds being used for the project in 2010.
- The limits of Highland Avenue are being modified in the TIP from “Wall Street to Fair Avenue” to “Third Street to 50’ west of Fair Avenue.”

- Musson and Lenze noted that the “total” project cost including engineering must be turned in for every project.
- There was \$65,361 remaining available for 2010. Village of Stevensville representatives noted that work on John Beers Road is direly needed, but that the remaining \$65, 361 would not be enough. Thus, it went to the Berrien County Road Commission to add to the Cleveland Avenue project.
- Cleveland Avenue is being amended in the TIP to absorb the remaining \$65,361 by changing the scope of work. A “sammy seal” will be done before microsurfacing work. Project cost was previously \$194,754 and scope of work was “Minor base repair and single microsurface.”

- Zebell noted that a segment of Kingsley Avenue is being added to the South State Street project. Thus the name “South State Street” is changing to “South State Street and Kingsley Avenue,” and the limits are changing to “South State Street from Granada Avenue to Wallace Avenue and Kingsley Avenue from South State Street to 100’ East of South State Street.”

- Musson stated that at the 2010-2013 TIP Project Selection Meeting, it had been agreed that Hollywood Road would be the next project in line in fiscal year 2014. Those present agreed that Hollywood Road should receive all funding in fiscal year 2014, in the amount of \$1,151,007. It is also receiving \$782,000 in fiscal year 2013.
- Berndt stated that unless a gas tax increase is passed in the State of Michigan, the Berrien County Road Commission will not be able to come up with the local match for the Hollywood Road project.
- It was asked whether Brown School Road is federal aid eligible, and Musson replied that he would check whether it is. {It is not, but has the potential to be changed to a federal aid-eligible road, so the application for the project should still be submitted.}

- A priority ranking was assigned to the top four illustrative projects, but not to the others. John Beers Road and Brown School Road were moved to the top of the Illustrative List although they had not been applied for at the beginning of the process, because of the dire condition of those two roads and the high rates of local contribution.
- Pipestone Street, which had been proposed for 2014 funding, was added to the Illustrative List.
- Aaron Anthony from the City of Bridgman proposed reconstruction of Lake Street from Church Street to Gast Road, in the amount of \$743,000. An application had not been submitted for this project. Lenze asked whether the amount could be reduced by breaking the project into smaller segments. Anthony stated that he would check into that and submit the applications to Musson.

- It was noted that it should be kept in mind which projects are GI-ready, so that it will be known which projects can be used for the first 50% of the funding and which can be used for the second 50%. This is important so that federal funding does not end up being lost. The engineering for the projects being used for the first 50% of the funding needs to be started immediately, as the legislation could be passed in March. Musson stated that he would keep track of “GI-readiness” in the Project Updates at the TwinCATS meetings.
