SWMPC TO VOTE ON ANNUAL WORK PROGRAMS for URBAN TRANSPORTATION

The SWMPC facilitates transportation planning for two urban areas. The Twin Cities Area Transportation Study (TwinCATS) is charged with planning for the Benton Harbor-St. Joseph urbanized area and the Niles-Buchanan-Cass Area Transportation Study (NATS) is charged with panning for the Michigan portion of the South Bend and Elkhart Urban areas. SWMPC has released drafts of the TwinCATS and NATS Unified Planning Work Programs (UWP) for fiscal year 2022, which begins October 1, 2021. The UWP is the annual work program for SWMPC staff, which describes all of the planning tasks funded by the US Department of Transportation, Michigan Department of transportation, and local jurisdictions.
